

Announcement of the Faculty of Political Science, Thammasat University on a Recruitment of Non-Thai Lectureships

The Faculty of Political Science, Thammasat University wishes to appoint the qualified, full-time non-Thai lectureships, as follows:

1. Required Position

2 non-Thai lectureships in Politics and International Relations

2. Qualifications

- 2.1 Non-Thai nationals
- 2.2 Graduate with MA or PhD in Political Science, International Relations and/or related fields, especially those with expertise in comparative foreign policy, diplomatic history or international political economy
 - 2.3 Excellent working levels of English (both writing and speaking skills)
 - 2.4 Experiences and abilities to convene and teach undergraduate modules

3. Application

- 3.1 The application form can be downloaded from www.polsci.tu.ac.th. Applicants can submit the application form together with all required documents at the Faculty of Political Science office, 2nd floor, the Faculty of Political Science building, Thammasat University, Tha-Prachan campus on weekdays from now until **April 30, 2023**. Applicants can also submit the application with required documents to mirrow tu.ac.th
 - 3.2 Required documents include:
 - 3.2.1 A certified copy of passport ID page
 - 3.2.2 A certified copy of certificates and transcripts of all education level
 - 3.2.3 An official photo (size of photo: 1 or 2 inches)
 - 3.2.4 A general medical examination certificate (no more than six months)
- 3.2.5 A full curriculum vitae/resume (including education background, work experiences and academic works, which are published in journals or presented at the international academic conferences)
- 3.2.6 Three letters of recommendation (At least, one of them from the university supervisor)
- 3.2.7 For non-native English speakers, an English test score certificate (TOEFL, IELTS, or TU-GET) is required. The score should be from a test date within three years.

5. The Selection Process and Criteria

5.1 On behalf of the Faculty of Political Science, the Recruitment of Non-Thai Lectureships Committee will consider the applications based on the applicants' education background, academic works, and work experiences.

5.2 The eligible applicants will be invited to have academic interviews and 45-minute lecture simulation.

5.3 For lecture simulation, the eligible applicants should prepare a handout on the topic which is selected by the Recruitment of Non-Thai Lectureships Committee. Lecture simulation is divided into two parts, as follows:

The presentation 30 minutesThe O&A session 15 minutes

6. Psychological Examination

The successful applicants need to pass the psychological examination according to the regulations of Thammasat University. The psychological examination will be held at the Social Service Department, 3rd floor, the Faculty of Medicine, Thammasat University, Rangsit campus.
